**Who should attend?**

Our **CLP Poison Centre notification requirements** workshop is aimed at business, regulatory managers and practitioners working in companies that will need to notify mixtures they place on the market. The workshop is ideal for anyone who needs to understand more about their obligations under the new Annex VIII of the Classification, Labelling, and Packaging (CLP) Regulations.

**Why attend?**

Article 45 of the CLP Regulation requires businesses to notify poison centres with information on mixtures that they place on the EU market. It affects almost all hazardous mixtures across the supply chain right through to the end consumer use. Attend this workshop to ensure you understand what it means for your business as well as the impact on your supply chains!

This workshop is designed to help companies with the practical implementation of CLP Article 45 and the new Annex VIII of the regulation. The programme provides an introduction to the key elements of the regulation and includes talks covering the implications for manufacturers, importers and users of chemicals throughout the supply chain. Also included is a practical session where participants will receive training on how to complete a submission using the available tools.

This workshop will:

- ✓ Explore the scope and exemptions of the regulation
- ✓ Describe the changes in making notifications to EU poison centres
- ✓ Take you through the new poison centre notification process
- ✓ Explain the various tools developed under the new regulations.
